




El Día de los Muertos, or the Day of the Dead, is here—and this board book is the perfect format to introduce the youngest readers to the holiday!








An unforgettable story about adolescence, perseverance, and one girl's struggle to be free while living in the Dominican Republic under the rule of a dictator.
